THE ROLE

- Maintain currency of complex databases
- Monitor performance metrics
- Produce regular reports that assist funding and payment decisions

This role requires attention to detail, analytical skills, and proficiency in data management tools.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

Data Processing:

- Collect and validate data from various sources to ensure accuracy and completeness
- Support the implementation and maintenance of data integration processes
- Monitor data quality and resolve any issues promptly with the Data Analyst or Data Hub Manager
- · Assist in recommending funding payments based on processed data

Data Monitoring:

- Regularly monitor data flows and system performance to ensure integrity and availability
- Generate routine and ad-hoc reports on data quality and system performance
- Collaborate with data colleagues to address technical issues affecting data processing

Data Analysis:

- Analyse data to identify trends and insights relevant to the region
- Maintain basic reporting dashboards to maintain accuracy
- · Work with stakeholders to understand data needs and provide relevant insights

Collaboration and Support:

- Assist the data analysts and other team members in data-related projects and initiatives
- Provide support and training to colleagues on data processes and tools
- Participate in team meetings and contribute to the continuous improvement of data operations
