- To define the West of England Combined Authority's approach to transport decarbonisation in order to meet its declared climate emergency. Provide management for, and coordinate, the development of the West of England's transport scheme programmes through early feasibility.
- To provide the Combined Authority's transport input and evidence required to support strategic growth
- To provide strategic transport advice to the Mayor and the constituent councils and be the Combined Authority's transport voice inputting to national and regional agendas.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Manage the Transport Team of the West of England Combined Authority.
- Manage and lead on the strategic transport functions of the West of England Combined Authority including the Joint Local Transport Plan, Bus Strategy, Local Cycling and Walking Implementation Plan, Rail Strategy and Key Route Network
- To lead the early development of the Combined Authorities Transport programmes and other transport projects and initiatives that arise.
- To lead the development and delivery of the West of England Combined Authority's approach to transport decarbonisation in order to meet its declared climate emergency.
- To lead, manage and deliver assigned key transport projects
- Manage and co-ordinate data and evidence to support the regions transport objectives and to monitor progress
- Lead on transport bids to Government and other agencies to maximise investment in the area.
- To provide the Combined Authority's transport input and evidence required to support strategic growth and lead on the transport Authority's response to regionally significant and cross boundary strategic development
- Monitor and manage spend from the West of England Combined Authority's transport policy budgets.
- Lead and co-ordinate the development, adoption and enactment of transport policies and schemes that assist the West of England Combined Authority in making best use of its capital and revenue resources.
- Provide strategic transport advice to the Mayor and the constituent councils on transport and planning functions.

- Provide a lead role in joint working with the constituent councils on developing and delivering transport strategies and schemes.
- Promote the role of the West of England Combined Authority as a Transport Authority.
- Engage with a range of stakeholders including Network Rail, National Highways, bus and rail operators and national and regional bodies.
